The Marriage License of Robert Nixon (25) of Grant Township, New Hanover County, NC and Jane Green (18) of Grant Township, with her parents, Fred and Elminny, is dated July 29, 1874. Robert Nixon's parents are listed as Israel and Nicey Nixon of Harnett Township, New Hanover County, NC.

The 1900 Federal Census notes Robert and Jane Nixon and their four children as living in the Topsail Township of Pender County, NC. Their granddaughter as well as a niece and a nephew are listed with them.

In 1910, Simon L. Nixon (27) is listed on the Federal Census as a married boarder, with wife Fannie (22). She is recorded as having given birth, but has no living children. The couple is boarding with Joe (23) and Mary J. Simmons (21), married one year with an infant daughter, Mary L. Simmons.

The 1910 Federal Census also lists Simon's sister, Minnie Nixon (29), as being married six years to David Nixon. They have five children between the ages of 9 and seven months old. Mary J. Nixon is not listed. She would be 20.

The 1920 Federal Census lists Simon (37) and Fannie (34) with a four year old daughter, Cora Lee.

There is a Cora Lee Nixon born on February 17, 1917 to Lawrence Nixon. The 1920 Federal Census lists Lawrence (28) and Nettie Shepard Nixon (26) with a son, Willie (4) and a daughter, Cora L. (2).

The Death Certificate of Cora Lee Nixon lists death as Laryngitis on February 6, 1925. She is nine years old. Her birthdate is listed as October 20, 1915, Long Creek, Pender County. Her father is listed as unknown. Her mother is listed as Lille Batts. Simon Nixon is listed as the informant.

There is a death notice for Lillie Batts September 14, 1918, Long Creek, Pender County, NC. It is assumed that Simon and Fannie Nixon raised the young Cora Lee until her death at nine years old.

The 1930 Federal Census lists the couple as owning their own home.

The 1940 Federal Census lists the couple as having a 3rd and 5th grade education, respectively.

The Death Certificate of Simon L. Nixon notes date of death as December 24, 1946, from a cerebral hemorrhage. His mother's maiden name is listed as Jane Green. He is buried in Pollocks Cemetery, Scotts Hill, NC. His mother is also buried at Pollocks Cemetery, Scotts Hill, NC.

The Death Certificate of Fannie Nixon notes date of death as June 4, 1960, and lists her husband as Simmon Nixon. Birthday February 7, 1886, and her parents as Mary Howard and Booker McClammy. She is buried at Pollocks Cemetery, Scotts Hill, NC.
