In the 1870 Federal Census, Christopher Jackson (33) and Levina (40) are listed in the Harnett Township of New Hanover County, NC. Henrietta Foster (20) is listed. She is the daughter of Levina. Children listed are Talton (7) and Prissilla (3).

The 1880 Federal Census notes Christopher Jackson, farmer, and wife Vina, keeps house, living in the Grant Township of Pender County, NC. They have four children. Talton is the oldest and listed as a farm worker. Silla is also listed as Drucilla. Julia Foster marries Mollie St. George. They have a son Elvin St. George.

In the 1880 Federal Census, Christopher Foster's household also includes step-daughter, Henrietta Nixon, listed as Mulatto with three children: Enoch (8), Laura (4) and Jerry (2).

In the 1890 Federal Census, Christopher Foster is listed as widower. Household empty.

1901 Marriage License issued on January 19 to Talton Foster (34) and Eliza Taylor (23), father listed as Andrew Taylor and mother as Anna.

In the 1910 Federal Census, Talton Foster is listed with a son, Willie (12). His father, Christopher "Kit" Foster (70) is listed below him. His household includes Elvin St. George (22), grandson; Laura Nixon (44 widowed) and listed as stepdaughter. Step grandsons and step granddaughter are listed as James (19), Hubert (14) and Lulla (10).

On December 13, 1921, neighbor Israel Jackson marries Talton's wife, Mary Lizzie Taylor Foster. See Israel Jackson family tree.

Talton Foster (61) dies on November 22, 1933. His Death Certificate lists him as widowed. The informant is Enoch Nixon.
